### **ACADEMICS-**

### **ACADEMIC ACHIEVEMENTS**

- We are proud to report that our class 10<sup>th</sup> students have brought honor to the school by their excellent results. We appreciate and congratulate the combined efforts of our teachers, students, and parents. **Our 10<sup>th</sup> class result for the academic year 2023-24 was 100 percent/ 61 students appeared and passed the class X examination. Prince Yadav with 95.2 %, Pragati Singh with 92.6%, and Sabhya with 91.8 % stood 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> respectively.** We congratulate all the students and

parents whose hard work and dedication made this possible.

- We also feel honoured to announce that one of our extremely talented students, **Mr Utkarsh Dhar Dubey, achieved 98.21% in JEE mains.** We heartily congratulate to Utkarsh and his proud parents for this achievement.
- 27 students appeared in All India Green Olympiad Examination which is based on the knowledge about environment and sustainable development and won certificates of participation and Kartik Tripathi from class 10<sup>th</sup> secured a certificate of merit.
- **English Week was celebrated from 17<sup>th</sup> to 24<sup>th</sup> July.** It was an exhilarating week filled with lots of activities such as rhyme recitation, show and tell, self-introduction, storytelling, calligraphy, quizzes for juniors and essay writing, story writing, slogan writing, book reviews, ad-designing, and debate competitions for seniors students. It gave students a platform to showcase their talents and encouraged them to overcome shyness, increased their knowledge and boosted their confidence.
- **Bharatiya Bhasha Utsav was celebrated** in October, 2023 to celebrate the birthday of renowned Tamil poet and freedom fighter Mahakavi Chinnaswami Subramania Bharati on 11 December where **students enjoyed learning the basics of two great Indian language 'Malayalam' and 'Punjabi'**. They learned numbers, alphabets, malayam songs and prayers and the basic phrases. They also performed a stage drama in Punjabi.

### **TEACHERS TRAINING AND CAPACITY BUILDING**

- Ms. Pratima Shahi (counsellor, therapist and trainer) with 14+ years of experience conducted an expert training session for empowering TNM teachers with invaluable skills in teaching methodologies and techniques to maximize students' learning potential.
- A workshop on 'Financial literacy and use of digital tools' was organised at T N Memorial Public School, Tilaura on 24<sup>th</sup> November. It was an initiative taken by CBSE in collaboration with Jeevitam to sensitize teachers on the basics of financial literacy. We had with us FCS Kamran Siddiqui as the speaker for the session.
- In-house teacher's training is done on every 2<sup>nd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> Saturdays about various topics such as classroom management, English training and personality development and various other topics which can improve the teaching quality.
- Currently, Teachers are attending an 'online training cum workshop' on the working and application of 'adobe express premium' and 'Canva for teachers' software in collaboration with adobe and CBSE. The software can be used for a variety of purposes by educators and students such as enhancing their presentations, teaching a topic in the simplest form using simple pictures and animations, for creating comic strips and templates using generative AI. It

will boost students' familiarity and working knowledge with the latest technologies in the field of computers.

## **FUTURE PLANS FOR THE UPCOMING SESSION 2024-25**

- We are working on building a robust infrastructure at TNMPS for subsequent academic pursuits. We have recently strengthened our IT facility with the purchase of more than 2 dozen computers having latest configuration to suit the needs of the students of 21st century and to keep them in sync with the rest of the world.
- Our Science and Mathematics lab are being constantly upgraded with the required equipment and chemicals to facilitate the practical needs of our students.
